

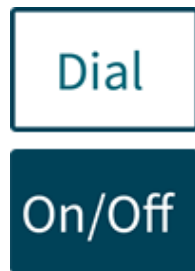


Call emergency services using TTY (Type and Read)



Step-by-step instructions

1.



For Uniphone TTY

Press the **dial** button. Type **106**.

For Superprint TTY

Press the black switch to turn on the TTY. Press **ctrl and 1**. Type **106** then press the return key.

2.

Read on the TTY screen.

“Emergency Relay Service press PPP for police...FFF for fire...AAA for ambulance. GA”
(Go ahead).

3.



Type:

- PPP, FFF or AAA,
- your exact location including street address and state
- then “GA” (go ahead).

4.



Wait for the Relay Officer to connect you with the Emergency Services Officer (ESO).

5.

Read the ESO's questions on screen and wait to read "GA" before typing your answer.

Type your answers then "GA".

Do not hang up until the Relay Officer tells you the call is finished.

6.



Read "goodbye" and "SKSK" (Stop Keying. Stop Keying). This shows that the ESO has hung up.

7.



Turn off the TTY.

For Uniphone, press shift and the TTY On/Off button.

For Superprint, press the black switch and hang up the handset.
