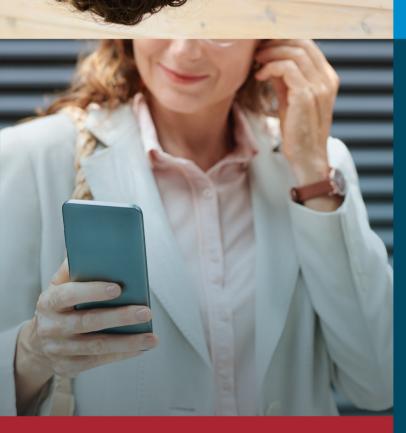

The NRS provides a range of different types of call services, depending on your needs and preferences.

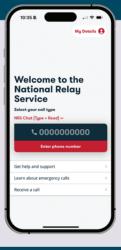
Relay Officers are specially trained staff who help with every call. Relay Officers will:

- Change voice to text or text to voice
- Change Auslan to English or English to Auslan
- Stay on the line throughout the call to help you
- Ensure calls run smoothly but will not change or interfere with what is being said



You can use the NRS app for relay calls. Available options include NRS Chat, Voice Relay, NRS Captions, and Video Relay.

The app is available for **free on the Apple and Google stores**for smartphones and tablets, and
it's a great option for making
relay calls on the move.
